

# Discussing limestone barrens

The limestone barrens of the Great Northern Peninsula will be the topic of a meeting of the Humber Natural History Society.

Anne Marceau, an interpretation specialist and Michael Burzynski, a vegetation biologist, both with Parks Canada at Gros Morne National Park, will be giving a talk at the meeting. The meeting takes place on Tuesday, Nov. 27 at Sir Wilfred Grenfell College in Corner Brook.

The talk, which will be illustrated by slides, will feature the plants of the northern limestone barrens and also some from similar habitats further south.
